The head of the T&P Cell, responsible for overall strategy, planning, and coordination of placement activities. Acts as a liaison between students, faculty, and recruiters.

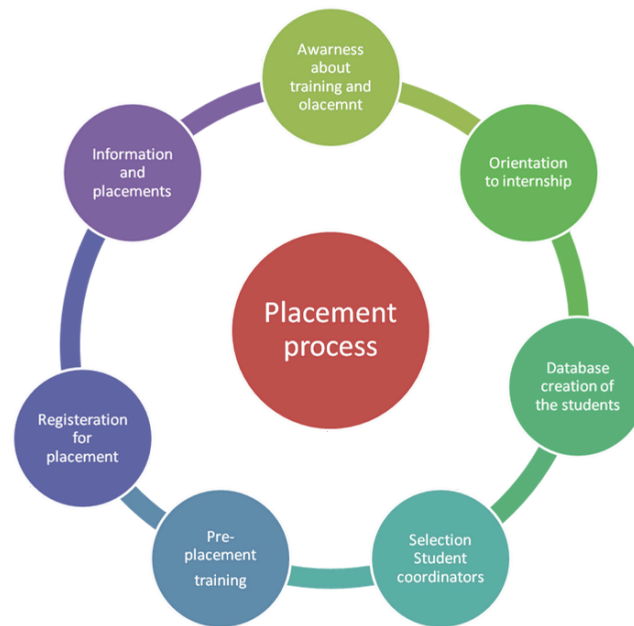
Faculty Coordinators:

Student Coordinators:

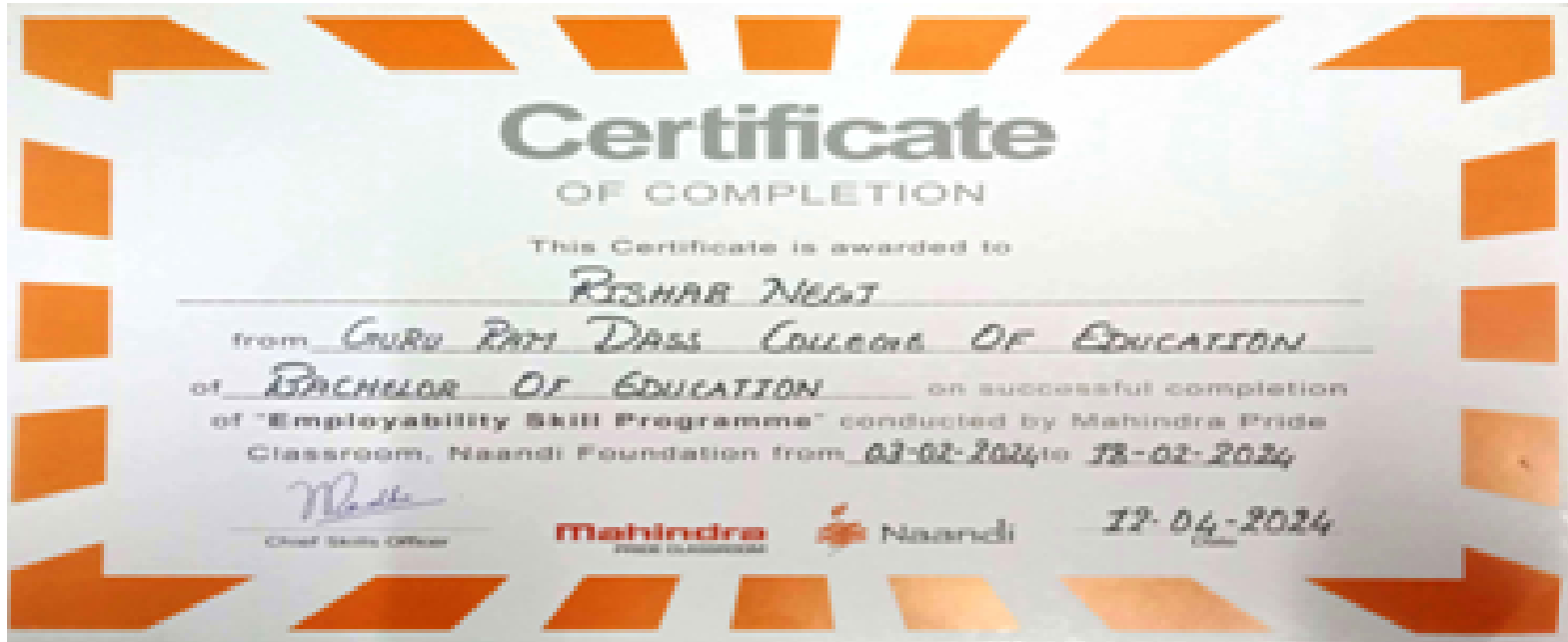
Selected students who help in organizing events, communicating with peers, and managing logistics for placement activities. Often act as a bridge between the T&P Cell and the student body
