

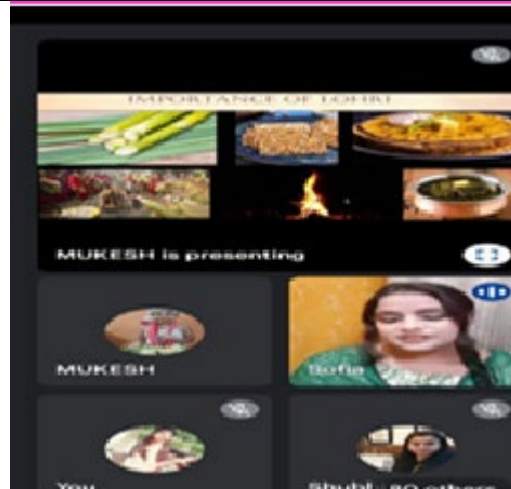





**Virtual Celebration of MakarSankranti –**

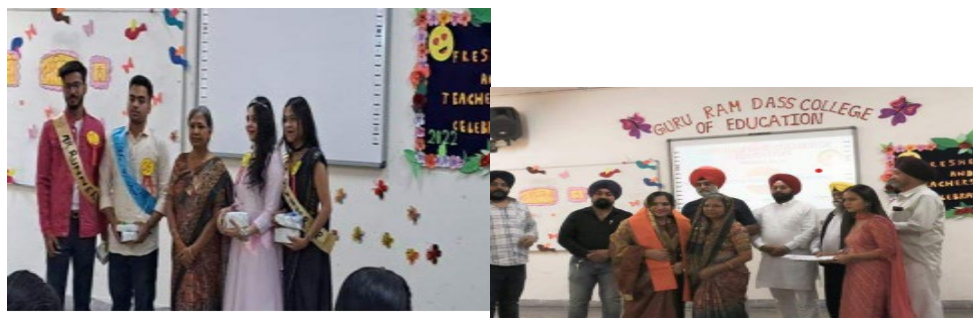

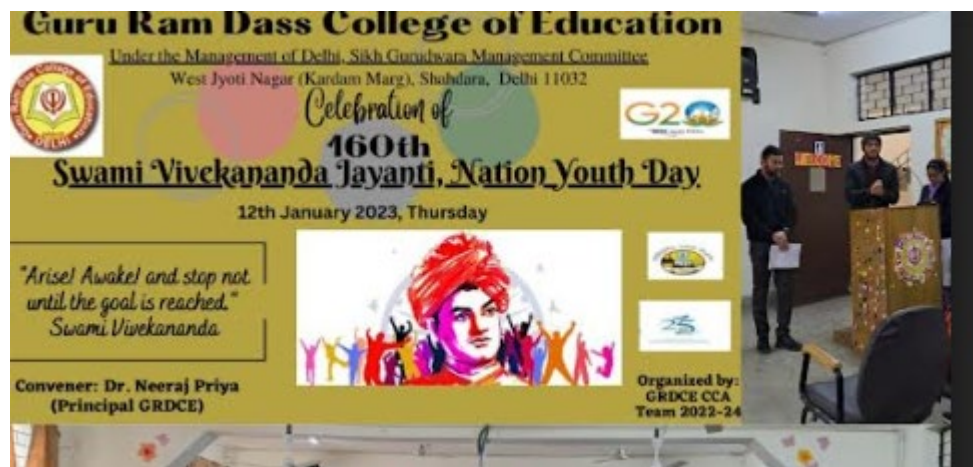

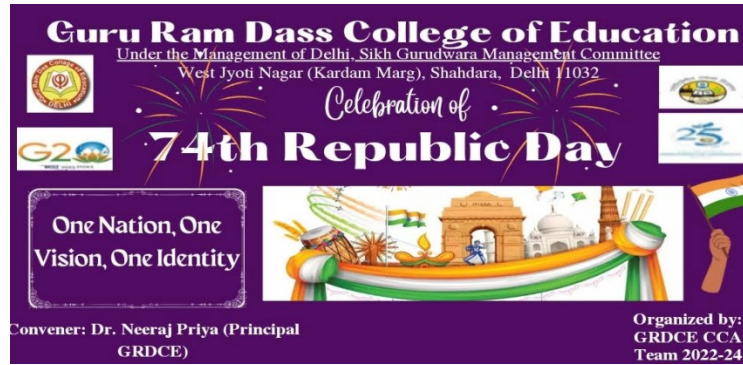


**Republic Day celebration**

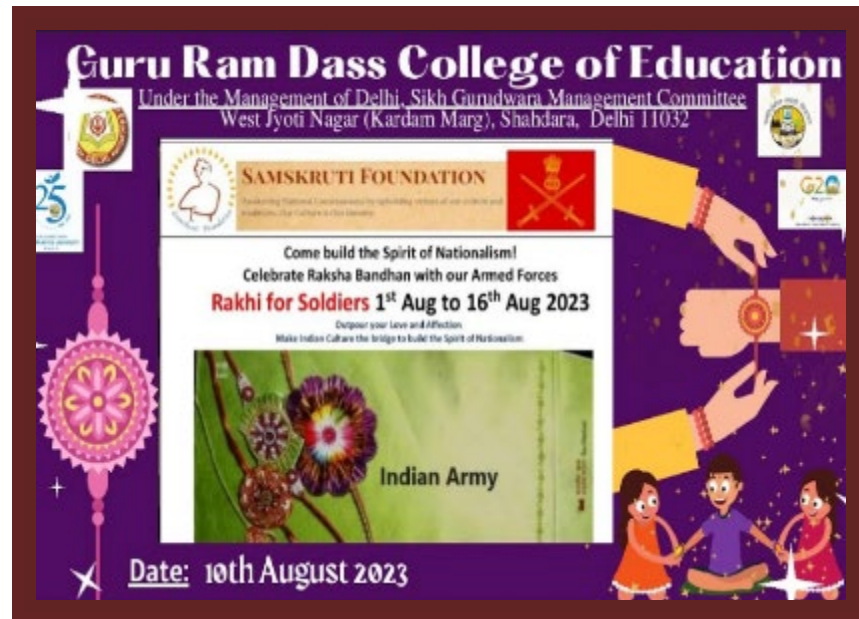
**Rakhi Celebrations, “



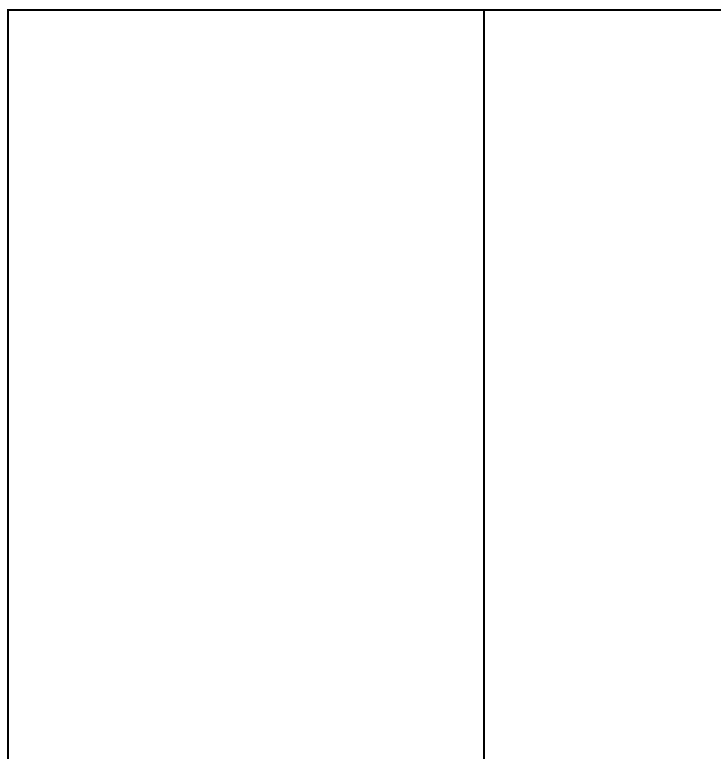

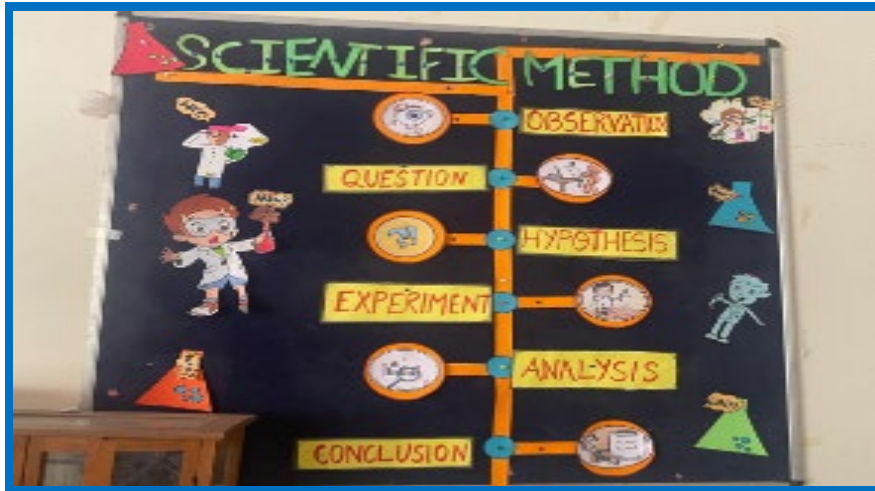
