## ANALYSIS OF THE REPORT

Most of the Faculty was satisfied with the institutional Environment, Support & Assistance and they recommended following points for improvement:

1. A separate reading corner in the library for the faculty was requested by the Faculty.

7. Plans under process for purchasing Turnitin & Quillbot software for faculty use.



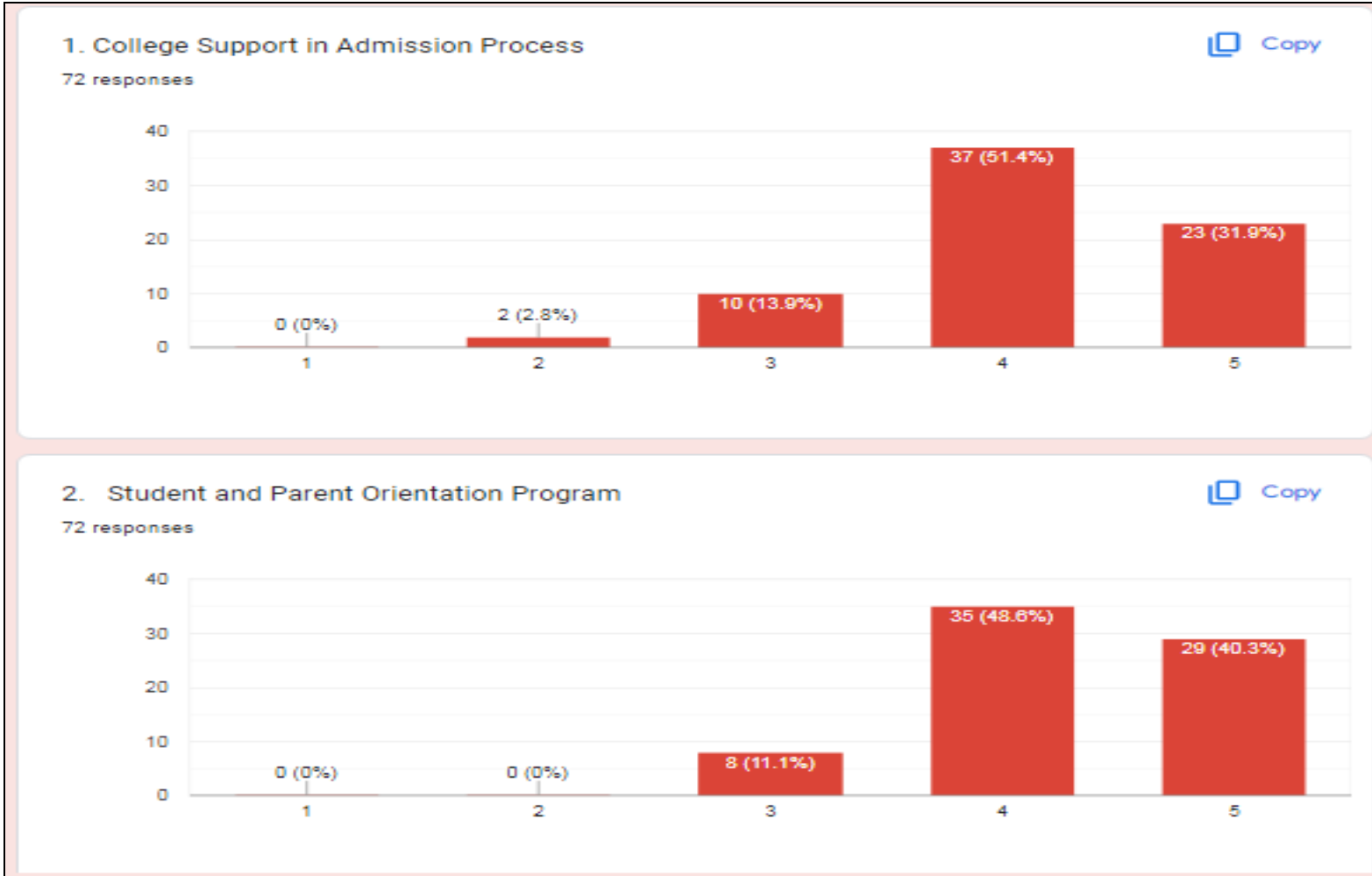

#### 16. Open ended Feedback:

- Students have generally positive sentiments about the college.
- Positive remarks about teachers and the college's overall quality.
- Common requests made by the students include improved Job placements, less assignments, better canteen food and personality development programs.,
- Some students have also requested for lounge area at the canteen for relaxing.
- Students have also requested for more CCA opportunities, like Inter House activities but some feel that they can be moved to a specific day or time only.
- Students have also requested for Library time in time table.
- Some students also want more computer courses for Integration of Technology in Teaching and Learning.
- Proper job guidance, with enhanced career services and placement support was requested mostly by the students.
- Students also requested for personality development programs.
- Students have requested for AC facility.
- Student have also requested for weekends off on Saturdays and College timing to be only till 2 pm.
- Students have requested for establishment of Music club and dance club in the college.
- Students want continuous availability of drinking water inside the building on every floor.
- A few students also wanted more scholarships made available to them.

Analysis:

In conclusion, students generally hold positive sentiments about the college, especially regarding the quality of education and faculty. However, they have made several requests for improvement, including better job placements, canteen food, and more opportunities for personality development and co-curricular activities. Addressing these concerns, along with enhancing facilities such as AC, library time, and weekend breaks, would further enrich the student experience and contribute to their overall satisfaction with the college.

### ACTION TAKEN

#### ACTION TAKEN

1. Job-oriented training & Value-Added Certificate courses were introduced to improve employability of students.
2. Students were made aware of more scholarships. Students were also provided opportunities for loaning books for long term from Library's Book Bank Service.
3. Library hours are extended, especially during exam periods, to accommodate students' study needs.
4. Canteen food quality was reviewed & a new menu was introduced based on students' feedback.
5. Students are provided with chairs & tables near the canteen for relaxed atmosphere.

6. More sports time was added to the time-table to encourage physical activity.
7. Innovative & interactive teaching methods were implemented & assignments overload is reduced.
8. LMS training sessions were conducted through Capacity Building Programs to address digital world challenges.
9. Time table is restructured to provide a better balance between academics & co-curricular activities. Long Assemblies have been shifted to Once a week for better student participation & engagement.
10. Air conditioning is already available in multipurpose hall, computer room & library. Due to financial constraints & commercial rates of electricity, it is not possible for the college to provide the same in classroom. In perspective of that, all the classrooms are big enough & have good ventilation for fresh air.
11. Water Taps are provided on each floor & regularly filled throughout the day, though water cooler is permanently installed near the canteen at ground floor.
